EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

This week: Adoration in St Patrick's on Friday 30 January at 7:30pm, concluding with Benediction at 8:15pm.

St Thomas Aquinas is thought of as perhaps the greatest Catholic theologian. But he is also one of the Church's foremost advocates of Eucharistic devotion, and helped explain the nature of the process by which the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. He also coined the term we use for this process: transubstantiation. He composed some of the hymns we know so well for Eucharistic Adoration, including *Tantum Ergo* and *Panis Angelicus*. These are his own words: "And this is done by Divine power in this sacrament; for the whole substance of the bread is changed into the whole substance of Christ's body, and the whole substance of the wine into the whole substance of Christ's blood. Hence this is not a formal, but a substantial conversion; nor is it a kind of natural movement: but, with a name of its own, it can be called 'transubstantiation.'"

Next week: Rosary and Adoration in St Mary's on Wednesday 4 February at 7:30pm, concluding with Benediction at 8:15pm.

Mon 26 Jan Ss Timothy & Titus, friends and collaborators of St Paul in his preaching. Timothy the first bishop of Ephesus, Titus bishop of Crete.

Tue 27 Jan St Angela Merici, born 1474, cared for unmarried women in community, providing education and training. Founder of the Ursulines

Wed 28 Jan St Thomas Aquinas, Dominican priest, theologian of truth, doctor of the Church. Patron of universities. Died 1274.

Fri 30 Jan St Aidan, born in Cavan, studied under St David in Wales and returned to the Wexford area as bishop famed for generosity and holiness.

Sat 31 Jan St John Bosco, born 1815, worked as a priest rehabilitating boys from crime and poverty. Founder of the Salesians. Patron of youth.
