St. Philip Neri had a great devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, observing that "Our sweet Jesus, through the excess of His love and liberality, has left Himself to us in the Most Holy Sacrament." He urges us, "Let all go to the Eucharistic table with a great desire for that Sacred Food. Thirsting! Thirsting!"

A renewed focus on the Eucharist can have a profound impact on our spiritual lives, if we are diligent and persistent. St. Philip offers some advice that is deeply practical for going forward with increased devotion to the Blessed Sacrament: "It is not a good thing to load ourselves with many spiritual exercises; it is better to undertake a little, and go on with it; for if the devil can persuade us to omit an exercise once, he will easily get us to omit it a second time, and the third, until at last all our pious practices will melt away."
