ORDINATION TO PRIESTHOOD

Rev Juan Jesús, our transitional deacon serving in the parishes of Moyraverty and Seagoe since October, will be ordained to the priesthood along with his colleague in Newry parish, Rev Callum Young. The ordination Mass will take place in St Patrick's Cathedral Armagh at **6:00pm on Tuesday 29 June**. Due to restricted numbers, attendance is by invitation only, but all may join by webcam on www.churchservices.tv/armaghcathedral.

We welcome Rev Juan's mother María Nieves and father José Antonio, his sisters Elena and Lucía and brother Andrés among us for this very proud and moving occasion for their whole family here and in Spain. The new priest will celebrate first Masses in each parish in the days that follow (see notices in bulletin). It is a cause of great rejoicing and we keep him in our prayers as he obeys the voice of the Good Shepherd: "Come, follow me."

Plenary indulgence is available for all who devoutly attend a first Mass of a new priest, and there receive Holy Communion, pray the Creed, and a prayer for the Pope's intentions, with the sacrament of Confession with any priest in the week before or after the first Mass. A plenary indulgence gains us the forgiveness of all sin and the expunging of all debt owed to God and others for the sins we have committed.

LYLO BLESSING OF GRAVES

Regrettably, pandemic conditions have not improved sufficiently for us to be able to hold public devotions in Lylo Cemetery for the blessing of graves. Current regulations permit a maximum of 500 people at outdoor gatherings, and our risk assessment for cemetery devotions indicates that typical numbers attending would be sure to exceed this limit. Therefore the planned cemetery devotions on 4 July will **not take place**.

Rest assured the parish clergy will bless the graves in the coming weeks and Mass will be offered in Lylo and St Anthony's for the faithful departed who lie at rest in St John's cemetery.
