ST PATRICK'S HEATING

On Wednesday last week we received notice from the diocese that approval is given for replacement heating system to be installed in St Patrick's church. This will be a change from oil to mains gas boilers, and we have asked the contractors to begin works soon as possible. We have also been given approval to start the tender process for repairs to the damp church walls, and then to begin work, which will be a major three-phased project. Thank you to the parish finance council for their work in pushing these projects forward with urgency.
