THE SUNDAY EUCHARIST

The people gathered for Sunday Mass are a demonstration of the whole Church across the world: the Bishop (or in his absence, the Priest) along with God's people around the one altar. Each community, gathering all its members for the 'breaking of bread', becomes the place where the mystery of the Church is concretely made present. Therefore, the 'Lord's Day', Sunday, is also the 'Church's Day'.



The Sunday assembly is the place where the Eucharist 'Sacrament of Unity' is celebrated, binding the people with the unity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. For Christian families, Sunday Mass is an outstanding expression of their unity when parents share with their children at the Table of the Word and the Bread of Life. It is first of all parents who must teach their children to participate in Mass every Sunday.

We gather on Sundays because it is the day of the Resurrection, so in one sense, every Sunday is a 'mini-Easter'. But even as we look back to the glory of that day, we look forward in hope to the final 'Lord's Day', the day of our own resurrection. We await the return of Jesus in glory, and in receiving the Eucharist, we get a foretaste of the joyful banquet in heaven. So, in this way, Sunday is the day of faith, but also the great day of Christian hope. This is why the Prayer of the Faithful responds not only to the needs of our own parishes, but also to those of all humanity, so at Mass the Church makes her own the joys and hopes, sorrows and anxieties of people everywhere, especially the poor and all who suffer.

WALK THE CROSS 2024

In 2023, over 600 people participated in Walk the Cross to Clonmacnoise, from north, south, east and west of Ireland.

This year, we will walk the 125km (78 miles) from Clonmacnoise to Dublin.

25km to be walked by each province: Ulster, Munster, Leinster and Connacht.

On the final day, walkers of all provinces meet and walk together for the final 25km into Dublin. We walk for our ancestors.

We walk for the unborn.
We walk for Ireland, for our children, our faith, the conversion of souls.

We unite our hearts to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

May those flames of love engulf Ireland and the whole world.

ARMAGH CITY TOURS

Armagh is an ancient city soaked in legends, history and heritage, the ecclesiastical capital of Ireland. One of the best ways to discover more about the story of this city and its people is a guided walking tour, taken at a leisurely pace, along a route of approximately 1 km. Your tour guide will entertain you with facts and anecdotes as they escort you towards the Hill of Armagh, where you will be treated to a feast for the eyes with the panoramic vistas from **Ard Mhacha**, the height of Macha.

The tours take place at 11am on Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays, and 2pm on Sundays, from 13 June–8 September and last approximately 90 minutes. They are suitable for age 6+. The tour starts outside Armagh County Museum and finishes at the Celestial Sphere at the bottom of Abbey Street.
