SAFEGUARDING REPORT

The Diocese of Dromore has published the Report of the Second Review of Child Safeguarding Practice in the Diocese undertaken by the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland at the invitation of Archbishop Eamon Martin, Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese.

The Review process, which began in March 2023, assessed compliance with Safeguarding Children Policy and Standards for the Catholic Church in Ireland, 2016. The Reviewers also looked at governance arrangements in the Diocese and any opportunities for learning and development.

In response to the report, Archbishop Martin said, "We are very much aware of the terrible wrong done to innocent children in the past and we are doing everything in our power to prevent anything like that happening again. I encourage everyone to read the Review report in full and to be vigilant to ensure that the Diocese remains fully committed to safeguarding today and in the future."

NOVEMBER INDULGENCES FOR THE HOLY SOULS

We can greatly help our loved ones in purgatory by offering an **indulgence** for them, by which God in his mercy forgives the sin which someone may not have had a chance to repent for before they died. In an indulgence, God abandons himself in love for us and remits the consequences of sin. Sin and its consequences are the very reason anyone may necessarily spend time in purgatory before going to heaven. The month of November is a special time when we can gain an indulgence for those who have died, and so help them to heaven. To prepare for an indulgence it is necessary to:

- * go to confession; and
- * receive Holy Communion; and
- * offer a prayer of your choice for the Pope's intentions.

Then a plenary (full) indulgence may be gained as follows:

a) From noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November, by visiting a church or chapel and praying one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed.

b) Once per day throughout the month of November, by visiting a cemetery, even in one's thoughts, and praying for the dead. Feel free to choose (a) or (b) or both.

By these prescribed ways, God's mercy is poured on those who need it most. Our communion with the Holy Souls means they will gratefully return prayers for you.

We can offer many diverse things for the sake of the Holy Souls: giving something up for November, perhaps saying the rosary or another prayer every day, going to Mass more often, or offering your own sufferings or difficulties. They will be most grateful for your thoughtfulness and God looks favourably on the communion we feel with those who have gone before us.

SAFEGUARDING SURVEY for survivors of abuse

The Irish Bishops' Conference, along with the Association of Leaders of Missionaries and Religious of Ireland, have commissioned consultants, RSM Ireland, to undertake a review of child safeguarding in the Catholic Church. One part of this review is to engage with survivors and victims of abuse to seek their views on Church Safeguarding processes. Specifically, RSM would like to hear from survivors who have disclosed abuse within the last twenty years to see what needs to be improved.
