## COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

## SOCIAL DISTANCING

Both parish pastoral councils and sub-committees have agreed to reduce the social distancing in all our churches. This means there will be a gap of one pew between occupied seats from now on, rather than two. There is now no limit on those who may attend a baptism, but masks should be worn by all using the church (see above).

## MISSION MONTH

This year's message — *We Cannot Remain Silent: we cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard* (Acts 4:20) — is twofold. It is a message of hope: Jesus Christ is risen and we cannot keep his love, mercy and compassion to ourselves. It also challenges us to stand up and speak out on behalf of those whose voices are too small to be heard. For them, we cannot remain silent.  
 October (Mission Month) is a time for the faithful of the world to show their appreciation towards the work of overseas missionaries. The generosity shown will be used to support their activity in over 1100 struggling dioceses, mostly in Africa, Asia and Latin America. The appeal will be made on Mission Sunday, 24 October.

## ORDINATION TO THE DIACONATE

This coming Thursday, 14 October, our senior candidate for the priesthood, Stefano Colleluori, will be ordained deacon. The Sacrament of Holy Orders will be conferred by Archbishop Martin during Mass in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh at 5:00pm on Thursday. Parishioners are most welcome to attend in person, or to follow online via [churchservices.tv/armaghcathedral](http://churchservices.tv/armaghcathedral). We welcome Stefano's parents, brothers and sisters from Italy among us for these few days, and wish him every fulfilment and grace in the deacon's ministry of preaching and service.
