**Two giants of faith through the drama of
their lives**

Patrick's time as
a young slave on
Slemish in Antrim
could easily have
turned his heart bitter
against his captors,
but instead he turned
to prayer "a hundred
times a day", doubtless
wondering how long
his captivity would
endure, and who
among his family
was thinking of him. When he returned
for the conversion of the Irish, and not for
their invasion or their punishment, we can
appreciate that Patrick must have seen his
awful experience of being a slave was not
pointless suffering, but preparation for the
work of his later life, and so he came to love
the Irish.



For Joseph, every time he's mentioned in the
Bible there is a crisis—the pregnancy of his
beloved betrothed
Mary; the lack of
accommodation
for her in time of
childbirth, but he
trusted in God's word
and providence.
When Herod seeks
to kill the child,
Joseph wastes no
time taking the
child and his mother
hundreds of miles on
foot into Egypt for
safe refuge—as refugees—because God
commanded him. Finally, there is the loss of
the 12-year-old Jesus in Jerusalem...imagine
the conversations with Mary, the cold fear,
and the relief mixed with confusion when
the boy is found. But Joseph put his own
feelings aside, took the boy home quietly,
and trusted in God while loving Jesus and
Mary like no-one else in history.



For St Patrick and St Joseph, not allowing
anything to come before God, trusting in
him through all adversity, accepting their
place in God's drama, makes them the
giants of faith that we celebrate this week.
