EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

This week: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in St Patrick's on Friday 2 May at 7:30pm, concluding with Benediction at 8:15pm

St Catherine of Siena, one of the greatest mystics and a doctor of the Church had a profound devotion to the Eucharist. Her confessor Blessed Raymond of Capua relates: "For the seven year period prior to her death, Catherine took no food into her body other than the Eucharist. Her fasting did not affect her energy, however. She maintained a very active life during those seven years. As a matter of fact, most of her great accomplishments occurred during that period. Her death had nothing to do with malnutrition, or anything connected with lack of food. In fact, Catherine was even "stronger in the afternoon, after having received Our Lord in His Eucharist" in the morning. She was completely satisfied physically and spiritually by receiving the Eucharist, and hungered greatly when she was unable to receive. REGINA CAELI

During the season of Easter until Pentecost it is customary to replace the Angelus prayer with the 'Regina Caeli', a prayer to Mary as Mother of the Risen Lord. It is recited at 12noon and 6pm, as for the Angelus, as follows:

Rejoice, O Queen of Heaven, **alleluia!**
For he whom it was your privilege to bear, **alleluia!**

Has risen as he said, **alleluia!**
Pray for us to God, **alleluia!**

Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, **alleluia!**
For the Lord has truly risen, **alleluia!**

Let us pray. O God, who were pleased to gladden the whole world by the resurrection of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech you that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, his Mother, we may enjoy the happiness of eternal life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
