SACRED HEART PILGRIM STATUE

Following Pope Francis' encyclical Dilexit Nos on the Sacred Heart last year, a novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is underway around Ireland with a pilgrim statue travelling the four provinces. The novena takes place on Fridays. The statue will arrive in the Church of the Sacred Heart, Dublin Road, Cloghogue, Newry on Friday 30 May, and Archbishop Eamon Martin will celebrate Mass at 7:00pm. The promises of the Sacred Heart to St Margaret Mary Alacoque will be shared. All are welcome to attend. The Mass will be streamed live on www.sacredheartcrusade.ie for those who cannot attend in person.

POPE LEO XIV INAUGURATION



Pope Leo's inauguration Mass takes place this Sunday morning in St Peter's Square. Prior to Mass, the Holy Father will pray before the tomb of St Peter in the Vatican grottoes, and early in the Mass he is formally bestowed with the pallium over his shoulders (symbol of his universal jurisdiction), and the Fisherman's Ring. A new ring is typically cast for each Pope, featuring St Peter and the Pope's name, since it was formerly used as a seal for official documents. It is destroyed after the Pope's death. The Inauguration Mass also allows visiting dignitaries and heads of state to acknowledge the beginning of the new papacy.
