Gift Aid is an arrangement that allows the parish as a charity to reclaim tax on a donation made by a taxpayer. This means every donation will be worth 25% more, at no extra cost to the giver. For example, with Gift Aid the charity can claim an extra 25p for every £1 donated, which makes a huge difference.

If you can support us with Gift Aid, you simply need to complete a Gift Aid Declaration. A Gift Aid Declaration is the giver's declaration that they wish the church to reclaim tax on their gift and can be made for a single donation or for multiple donations. Please contact the Parish Office, or fill out the gift aid declaration forms at the back of the church and leave in the collection box/basket.

JULY: MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD

Many months of the year have a particular devotion associated with them, the best known being May for Our Lady, November for the Holy Souls, June for the Sacred Heart.

The devotion for the month of July is to the **Precious Blood of Jesus**. Doing honour to his Blood recognises his sacrifice to take our sins away and offer salvation to humanity. It is also his gift to us in the Eucharist, received under the appearance of the host (the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ). He lost his blood for our sake, that we might gain everlasting life.

This self-sacrifice is often depicted in imagery of a pelican, seen in stained-glass windows, artwork, mosaics, etc since medieval times. Legend held that when a mother pelican's young were attacked by a snake or dying, she would pierce her own breast to feed them from her blood, which would heal and restore them to full strength even at the expense of her life. It is a stunning symbol of Christ.

Admitted to your sacred table, O Lord, we have with joy drawn water from the fountains of the Saviour: O may his blood become within us a fountain of water springing up to eternal life.

Mass in honour of the Precious Blood will be celebrated on Tuesday 12 July. All welcome
