DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

The Divine Mercy Novena begins this Good Friday and finishes on the Second Sunday of Easter/ Divine Mercy Sunday (24 April this year). Be assured of God's loving mercy this Easter by taking part and attending Mass and confession (see times below). The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is said on ordinary rosary beads and each day of the novena has an intention for different groups of people (souls).

In this Pastoral Area, the novena will conclude with Mass and Chaplet prayers at 3pm on Divine Mercy Sunday, held in St Peter's Lurgan. Please note there will NOT be confessions available in St Peter's that day so please avail of the opportunities for confession during Holy Week, or ask a priest at any time.

WELCOME BACK TO WORSHIP

With restrictions greatly eased, this Holy Week-Easter marks the time when everyone is invited and encouraged to return to Sunday Mass. The Irish Bishops say, "the Sunday Eucharist is our greatest act of thanksgiving...we encourage everyone to return to Sunday and weekday Mass in our churches, welcoming each other back as we gather once more together. From Easter Sunday, 17 April, this will once again be deemed an essential expression of faith for all in our Church in Ireland. As always, those whose health is vulnerable or who are unwell will not be under any obligation to attend Mass."
