CORONAVIRUS RESTRICTIONS

The latest NI Executive restrictions to limit the
 spread of Covid-19 begin at 12:01am on St
 Stephen's Day and last for six weeks.

During this period, churches will remain open
 and Masses, baptisms, marriages and funerals
 may continue with congregations whilst
 observing strict social distancing measures.
 Face masks are mandatory while in the
 building, entering and exiting (specific
 exemptions apply).

Funerals and weddings are limited to 25
 people.

The parish office will be closed to visitors for
 the duration of these restrictions but open to
 phone calls, post and e-mail correspondence.
