ROSARY PRAYER TO SAINT JOSEPH

The following prayer is traditionally added to the rosary in October. It was composed by Pope Leo XIII in 1889, and asks St Joseph to pray for us after we have invoked his Spouse, Mary, in the rosary.

To you, O Blessed Joseph, we have recourse in our tribulations, and while imploring the aid of your most holy Spouse, we confidently invoke your patronage also. By that love which united you to the Immaculate Virgin, Mother of God, and by the fatherly affection with which you did embrace the Infant Jesus, we humbly beseech you graciously to regard the inheritance which Jesus Christ purchased with His Blood and to help us in our necessities, by your powerful intercession.

Protect, O most provident Guardian of the Holy Family, the chosen children of Jesus Christ; ward off from us, O most loving father, all taint of error and corruption; graciously assist us from Heaven, O most powerful protector, in our struggle with the powers of darkness; and as you did once rescue the Child Jesus from imminent peril to His life, so now defend the Holy Church of God from the snares of her enemies and from all adversity.

Shield each one of us with your unceasing patronage that, imitating your example and supported by your aid, we may be enabled to live a good life, die a holy death, and secure everlasting happiness in Heaven. Amen.

LOURDES PILGRIMAGE 2023

The Dromore diocese intends to organise a 5-day pilgrimage to Lourdes in May 2023 (exact dates and price to be confirmed).

Unfortunately, due to the pandemic it will be a different kind of pilgrimage, as we will not be using the hospital accommodation (Accueil) in Lourdes and will therefore be unable to support an assisted section in 2023. This means we will not have the same support from doctors, nurses, and volunteers as we had pre-pandemic. All pilgrims will be accommodated in the hotels and will therefore need to be independent, or bring a relative or friend for assistance.

The pilgrimage will include general insurance cover (to include Covid-19 cover), transport to/from airports, a programme of ceremonies in Lourdes, and assistance of travel agent representatives in Lourdes.

If you are interested in travelling to Lourdes as a pilgrim in May 2023, please contact the parish office no later than Friday 25 November 2022 to declare your interest.

OCTOBER: MISSION MONTH MISSION SUNDAY

Next weekend we will celebrate World Mission Sunday, the Holy Father's annual appeal to support overseas mission and missionaries. Since the pandemic, there have been fewer people physically attending Mass, meaning fewer offerings in the basket. The implications for overseas missionaries and the communities they serve over the coming months will be very challenging. The needs of young dioceses vary, anything from a motorbike so a priest can celebrate Mass in a remote village, to a community hall so local people can gather in safety; or more urgently, vaccinations and medicines so that parish dispensaries can protect vulnerable children. Your donation will help

- provide basic infrastructure by helping communities to build schools, clinics, parish halls and churches

- prepare the future leaders and carers of the Church by supporting the training of sisters, priests, brothers and catechists

- support missionary programmes to care for children's spiritual and physical wellbeing by offering safe shelter, healthcare, education and hope for the future.
