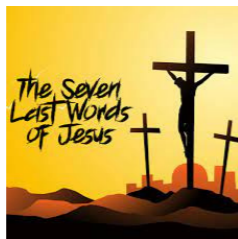

*The Irish Bishops recently met together and
issued the following statement of advocacy for
the people of the Holy Land:*

"In this Season of Lent, we Christians prepare
for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery of
Christ's Death and Resurrection, as Muslims
prepare for the Season of Ramadan, and Jews
prepare for the celebration of Passover. We
urge people to continue praying and fasting
for the intention of peace. In praying for
peace in the land of Jesus Christ, the Prince
of Peace, we remember in a special way the
small but vibrant Christian communities in
Palestine. An ideal way of showing solidarity
at this time is to support Trócaire's Gaza
appeal on www.trocaire.org."

COMMEMORATIONS OF THE WEEK

*No commemorations of saints this week as the
Church's total attention is given to marking the
days of salvation in Holy Week.*

*NB: The celebration of the Annunciation, usually
25 March, will be held on 8 April this year.*



This week is holy because of the saving
action of Jesus Christ for you, for me, for us.
This is when the Son of God took on the
forces of evil and death, and conquered
them with love.

This is where the drama of God's self-
emptying revealed the depths he would go
to out of love for us.

So...

...if you appreciate the gift of priesthood
...if you are renewed and restored by God's
forgiveness again and again

...if you are thankful for the gift of the
Eucharist

...if you are hopeful of eternal life with God
...then know that all these incredible gifts
flow directly from Holy Week, and you need
to be taking part in the celebrations that
take place in your parish on Palm Sunday, on
Holy Thursday and the days that follow.

Be with us, be with God's people who are
thankful to him for these amazing days,
hence in Irish we call it **An tSeachtain Mhór**
— **the Great Week.**
