Pope St Paul VI said, *"All of us realise that there is more than one way in which Christ is present in His Church...but there is another way that surpasses all the others. It is His presence in the Sacrament of the Eucharist, which is, for this reason, "a lovelier object of contemplation and holier in what it contains" than all the other sacraments; for it contains Christ Himself and it is 'a kind of consummation of the spiritual life, and in a sense the goal of all the sacraments.'" Next week: Rosary and adoration in St Mary's on Wednesday 11 June, concluding with Benediction at 8:15pm.*

REGINA CAELI

Mon 2 Jun Ss Marcellinus & Peter, *exorcist and priest, martyred in 304, held in high honour in Rome.*

Tue 3 Jun St Kevin, *hermit and abbot at Glendalough, died in 618.*

Wed 4 Jun Ss Charles Lwanga & companions, *22 Ugandan martyrs of many Christians put to death between 1885–87.*

Thu 5 Jun St Boniface, *English missionary bishop to Germany, martyred in 754.*

Fri 6 Jun St Jarlath, *bishop, founder and patron of Tuam archdiocese*

JUNE – MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS



This year marks the 350th anniversary of the apparitions of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque with the revelations about his Sacred Heart at Paray-le-Monial in France in 1675. St Claude de la Colombière was the Jesuit priest and confessor with whom St Margaret shared the revelations. Together they began to zealously spread devotion to the Sacred Heart.

Last week the Bishops said, *"We in Ireland must pray for a change of heart. Throughout the month of June—the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus—we call on everyone to pray for an outpouring of the compassion of God on a heartless world."*

To see the relentless bombardment of civilian areas, the deliberate withholding of food from the starving, as well as the callous holding of hostages, it appears that humanity has lost its heart. In the face of these horrors, we invite everyone to turn to the heart of Jesus throughout the month of June by praying for the renewal of heart that our world so desperately needs."

During this month there will be a number of initiatives to promote devotion and prayer to the Sacred Heart.

* The **relics of St Margaret Mary Alacoque and St Claude** arrived in Sacred Heart Church, Cloghogue, Newry, on Friday 30 May and will remain there until Thursday 5 June. All are welcome.

* The Bishops call on all Catholics to mark the first **Friday, 6 June**, as a day of **prayer and fasting for peace** and in solidarity with our sisters and brothers suffering so grievously in the Holy Land.

* Consecration of Ireland to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on 22 June.

* Promotion of the Sacred Heart Novena (19–27 June) will take place across the diocese.

* We hope to arrange a visit from the Jubilee statue of the Sacred Heart to our parishes in July.
