## THE HOLY SPIRIT AT MASS



Chances are you're reading this bulleting before or after Mass, so did you know that the Eucharist takes place because of the action of the Holy Spirit? Let's look how the Holy Spirit is working throughout the Mass:

- \* At the beginning, the priest wishes the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. The Holy Spirit brings us together in each Mass.
- \* In the Gloria and the Collect (Opening Prayer), we glorify and petition the Holy Spirit together with the Father and the Son: God as Trinity.
- \* During the readings, "under the action of the Holy Spirit, the Word of God may be grasped by the heart".
- \* In the Creed, the Holy Spirit prompts us to faith and belief, and we 'adore and glorify' God the Holy Spirit.
- \* During the Eucharistic Prayer, as the priest spreads his hands over the bread and wine, the words he says call the Holy Spirit to descend and make the Sacrament possible: the transformation into the Body and Blood of Christ happens because of the Holy Spirit's action.
- \* Receiving Holy Communion: pray that the Spirit makes you one with Christ, and one with each other.
- \* Final blessing is given by the Holy Spirit in unison with the Father and Son.
