Cemetery: St Patrick's Cemetery will remain open and accessible for burials and visits to graves by the top gate (Corner House end). The swing gate will be out of use.

Funerals: Requiem Masses will be celebrated in St Mary's Derrytrasna, proceeding afterwards to St Patrick's Cemetery for interment.

First Communion and Confirmation for St Patrick's PS will take place on the agreed dates and times, but in St Mary's Derrytrasna, i.e. Confirmation for both schools: Wednesday 26 April at 7:00pm

First Holy Communion on Saturday 20 May: St Patrick's PS at 11:00am St Mary's PS at 1:00pm.

COMMEMORATIONS OF THE WEEK

No saints are commemorated this week; the Church's full attention is given to the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ the Lord.



"Hosanna" is a Hebrew exclamation of praise. It can mean save us, or salvation. By greeting him with "hosanna," the people show that they were aware that Jesus was the Messiah. They believed that he would save them; at least they did on Palm Sunday. Later that week, they condemned him to death. The fickle crowds didn't want him anymore.

We can know in our hearts that Jesus is our Saviour but deny him with the way that we live our lives. We can know his commandments but not follow him. We can intend to pray but we never show up.

Our reaction to Jesus doesn't change who he is. On both Palm Sunday and Good Friday, he was and still is our Saviour. Whether we follow him or stray, he still pursues us. He suffered and died for all. Whether we shout "Hosanna!" or "crucify him!" Jesus still willingly gives up his life for us. It isn't our love for him that led to his Passion and Death, but it was his unwavering love for us.


GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION
