## REGINA CAELI (QUEEN OF HEAVEN)

During the season of Easter until Pentecost it is customary to replace the Angelus prayer with the 'Regina Caeli', a prayer to Mary as Mother of the Risen Lord. It is recited at 12noon and 6pm every day, as for the Angelus, as follows:

Rejoice, O Queen of Heaven, **alleluia!**  
For he whom it was your privilege to bear,  
**alleluia!**

Has risen as he said, **alleluia!**  
Pray for us to God, **alleluia!**

Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, **alleluia!**  
For the Lord has truly risen, **alleluia!**

Let us pray.  
O God, who were pleased to gladden the whole world by the resurrection of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech you that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, his Mother, we may enjoy the happiness of eternal life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
