EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

This week: Adoration in St Patrick's on Friday 15 November at 7:30pm, concluding with Benediction at 8:15pm.

St Albert the Great affirms the Body of Christ is truly present in the sacramental species; he proposes that the Body of Christ is also in the stomach of the disciple who receives the Eucharist, and also in the stomach of someone who receives it unworthily. However, if someone receives the Body of Christ unworthily, they do not receive its beneficial effects, but rather great damage.

Albert says that the type of nourishment provided by this food is spiritual, and its aim is that we remain in Christ, since Christ, by his union with the divinity, is the source of perpetual life. In the case of the Eucharist, this food contributes to the truest life possible for a human being, the life of grace and glory. *Next week: Adoration and rosary in St Mary's on Wednesday 20 November at 7:30, finishing with Benediction at 8:15pm.*

Thu 14 Nov St Laurence O'Toole, abbot of Glendalough, then archbishop of Dublin. Defender of his people against the Normans. Patron of Dublin.
Fri 15 Nov St Albert the Great, gifted scholar of theology, philosophy and the sciences, hence known as the Universal Doctor (of the Church).



MISSION AWARENESS VISIT

What is Viatores Christi?

Viatores Christi (VC), is an association of lay Catholic missionary/development workers, founded in 1960. VC brings about positive change by improving access to healthcare, education and livelihood opportunities in the marginalised communities in which we work.

Why are they talking at the Masses?

- To raise awareness about the missionary work of the Church and the role of lay missionaries, both at home and overseas.
- To thank the people of the Dromore Diocese for your support for our work over the years
- To offer an opportunity and preparation to anyone who feels called to volunteer.
- To appeal for ongoing help both financially and above all through prayer.

There will be an exit collection in aid of the work of VC.

WHY PRAY FOR THE HOLY SOULS?

"All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. "The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. The Church formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially at the Councils of Florence (15th c.) and Trent (16th c.) "This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: 'Therefore [Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin' (2 Maccabees 12). From the beginning the Church has honoured the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the [Mass], so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead" (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1030–1032).
