EASTER DUTY

This Precept of the Church draws the Catholic faithful directly into the heart of the Paschal Mystery, hence the minimum obligation to receive the Eucharist at least once during the Easter season (ordinarily Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday). By the same token, anyone conscious of serious sin is obliged to confess it and be reconciled before receiving Holy Communion.

These stand in addition to the precept to attend Mass every Sunday and holyday. Not to do so is an example of a serious sin.

Those for whom it is impossible to fulfil their Easter duty are excused. The ancient tradition maxim in Church law applies here: "No one is bound to do the impossible."

TOGETHER FOR A JUST WORLD

Trócaire, meaning 'mercy', is an excellent recipient for your almsgiving this Lent. This year the Lenten campaign features a family from Rwanda, led by the strong woman Uwamahoro looks for work every day in order to support her daughter, 7, niece aged 12 and her mother who is disabled. They are vulnerable to the rainstorms which have destroyed their basic home, and the crops in the field, a source of income. Very often Uwamahoro will go without food in order to provide for her children, especially that they might have an education, their key to a better future.

The projects Trócaire help in this part of Rwanda help families to repair or rebuild homes, provide small livestock and cooking stoves, offer health insurance for vulnerable households, and foster resilience in helping families adapt to climate change.
