ST PATRICK'S RE-OPENS


Saint Patrick's is now open again for normal use (Masses, baptisms, weddings, funerals, adoration and personal visits), although the interior is not yet completely finished. Massgoers will see that all the old plaster has been entirely removed from the walls of the church, and the walls are now roughly plastered with what is called a **scud coat**. This both helps to continue drawing dampness out of the stonework, while also keeping the dust from the unfinished walls to a minimum. It will remain in place for approximately six months, after which the church will close again for final re-plastering and decoration. The only section of completed plasterwork which has been finished at this point (because the stonework there was not damp) can be seen surrounding the two stained glass windows in the sanctuary on both left

Outside, the contractors continue with the repointing work on the exterior stonework, working from front to back. As this proceeds, it should be possible for scaffolding to be removed gradually from around the front of the church to begin with. The estimated completion of exterior works will be in September.

The normal Mass schedule (see top of page) resumes, and anniversaries may be booked for these Masses for the next six months. Baptisms may also be booked for the second and fourth Sundays of each month. Please contact the parish office for all such requests. Thank you...

STUDY THE FAITH
