ACN has worked with the Catholic Church in Ukraine for decades, and the Church is staying put to minister to the faithful during their hour of need. They give this testimony from Fr Roman Laba, priest of the Catholic parish of Brovary: "Yesterday our town was again attacked by ballistic missiles. One person was killed and five were injured. At the moment we are calm. Every day there are about 80 people in our parish, mostly women and children. We all ask God for protection and salvation. For the last five days we have been praying to Saint Michael the Archangel. Every day we seek consolation in God's word: 'Make a new song to the Lord, because he has done works of wonder. With his right hand and with his holy arm he has overcome.' Please—pray for Ukraine."
